The Government of Assam (GoA) and the Gates Foundation (GF) have entered into a partnership to improve health outcomes, including MNH, in the state. The Gauhati Medical College has been designated by the GoA as the nodal agency to facilitate TA support from the GF to improve maternal and child health outcomes in all the districts of the states while focusing on Districts with a high burden of adverse outcomes. The TA approach has been developed in consultation with the GoA leadership and will be provided through targeted strategies and district level support. The whole effort will be based on a HUB-SPOKE model where a State level PMU will be at State HQ with 6 Technical staffs each having specific expertise who will be responsible for providing TA to all the Districts of Assam along with the District Nodal Consultant (DNC).
